The Constitution of the Kingdom Psalm 19:7-14

Reflection: According to the Merriam Webster dictionary, constitution is the basic principles and laws of a nation, state, or social group that determines the powers and duties of the government and guarantees certain rights to the people in it. It's an established law or custom. Every kingdom must have a constitution. A country without a constitution will lead to chaos.

The Bible is the Constitution of the Kingdom of God. No two-thirds majority of any parliament on earth can change it. Democratic vote or consensus does not decide Bible truth. "Forever, O Lord, Your word is settled in heaven" (Psalm 119:89). We have a constitution that is perfect, eternal. It does not need amendment because God who is eternal, omnipotent and omniscient authored it. He does not change His mind because He never makes a mistake.

Even though God (through the Holy Spirit) is the author of the kingdom constitution, He himself is also subject to the constitution (Psalm 138:2). Also our kingdom constitution is written with the citizens in mind. It is meant to bless, enlighten and empower the citizens. Hence any citizen who abides by the kingdom constitution is like a wise man that built his house on the rock and that house will be able to withstand any kind of storm. (Matthew 7:24-27)
