This story is based on Exodus 14:15-16, 21-22, 31.

Moses loved God. (Find Moses.) God chose Moses to lead the Israelites, people who loved God, to a new home. Tromp, tromp went the people. Tromp, tromp went the animals as they followed Moses. (Pat knees.)

Suddenly Moses stopped walking. Splish, splash, splish, splash. He was by a big sea of water. (Move arms like waves.)

The Israelites cried, "How can we cross the sea? Now we cannot go to our new home."

God heard the people. He told Moses what to do. God said "Hold your arms over the sea. I will make the water move apart."

Moses stretched out his arms. God made the water move apart.

Tromp, tromp. The people and animals went through the sea on dry land. Moses went through the sea too. Moses and the Israelites praised God. They thanked God for His great power and for their leader, Moses.

Lesson 3

Follow the Leader

Bible Truth: God gives us leaders.
