A religious teacher invited Jesus for a meal. Jesus surprised him. Jesus did not wash His hands in the special way that teachers washed.


Jesus knew what the teacher was thinking. Jesus said, "You only care about how you look on the outside. You don't think about being clean inside."

Really love God; don't just put on an act.

Love God Reminders

Have your child cut small hearts from construction paper and place them in key spots that will serve as reminders to show love for God this week (such as on a mirror, a toy shelf, or book).

Memory Verse Activity

Have your child practice the verse with these motions, repeating a motion every time the word is said:

Lord—point up

Look at—shade eyes with hand

People—point to self

Appearance—draw circle around face

Heart—outline heart on chest
