- Completed application
- Official High School or College transcript with official seal(s) and signature(s) in a sealed envelope.
- Two letters of recommendation:
 - One letter from a High School teacher, guidance counselor, College advisor or College professor that attests to the educational success and potential of the applicant
 - One letter from a representative of a community service organization attesting to the applicant's active participation (it can be a church member).
- Minimum one page (double spaced) essay that attests to the applicant's commitment to giving to their community and career goals.
