The Good Samaritan Scholarship - \$1,000

 - o If a certificate program, cost of program must be more than \$1000 or difference must be applied to other school supplies such as books, lab fees, etc.
- Applicant must have demonstrated activities where they have given of their time and talents to the needs of the church

Applicants must submit the following:

- Completed Application
- Proof of acceptance to an accredited College, University or Tech School
- Two Reference letters:
 - From someone that can describe the church work or servant role demonstrated by the applicant
 - o From an SBCOD church leader or member that has interacted with the applicant and can vouch for their spiritual well-being to serve the Lord.
- Essay on the following topic
 - Why do you think you demonstrate the actions of the Good Samaritan in the parable found in Luke 10:30-37?
- Please ensure that the application is signed
